- Federal, state and institutional aid are posted directly to the student’s portal account.
- Award amounts are generally disbursed equally after census day over all semesters in an award year.
- Disbursement of aid will be delayed or cancelled if the student’s financial aid file is incomplete. Deadline will be provided during your financial aid appointment.
- Financial Aid funds are applied first to cover direct costs such as: **tuition, fees, room and board**. If funds remain, a refund check will be issued 10 days after funds are disbursed 100% in the student’s account. Please check with the Business Office for more information about refund checks.
- Awards are based on full-time enrollment (Undergraduates 12 units/ Graduates 9 units).
- If you will not be registered full-time for a semester, financial aid adjustments will occur after census day. Please check with your financial aid counselor if you are considering attending less than full time. An appeal must be completed and approved so your institutional aid is adjusted accordingly.
- Federal student loans (subsidized / unsubsidized) require a student to be enrolled at least half time to receive student loans. If you are enrolled less than half-time in a semester, your student loans will be cancelled.
- Marymount California University policy requires students who receive any form of institutional aid to be enrolled at least full-time.
- In order to remain eligible to receive federal and state financial aid, students must continue to meet SAP requirements. Eligibility requirements for assistance from the federal and state financial aid programs are contingent on students’ meeting the minimum Qualitative (GPA) and Quantitative (pace) standards within a Maximum Time Frame (150%).
- Graduate Students are not eligible for institutional aid.
- Athletes with Athletics Scholarships are not eligible for Marymount Grants.
- Any student who withdraws during the first 60% of the semester may owe grant/loan funds to the government and MCU. There is no exception on this rule and you cannot appeal for this decision.
