

According to state regulation, Marymount California University must have a student's written authorization to credit Cal Grant B Access amount to the student's account, and the written consent must be retained by the school in the recipient's records.

Without this authorization, the school must release these funds directly to the student. A student has the ability to reverse his/her authorization prior to the disbursement of funds and receive the access funds directly.

Students are responsible for any outstanding balance charges on their account.
