Any area of emphasis defined in the Multidisciplinary Studies BA program may be added to another Bachelor's degree as a minor. The minor may not be the same discipline as the degree. A minor added to the Multidisciplinary Studies BA requires completion of a third emphasis, since the Multidisciplinary Studies BA itself requires two emphases. Courses may not be applied to more than one area of emphasis.

Limitations are in place when more than 1 course is required/taken in both the major and minor. Examples are:

Accounting BS and Business minor
Biology BA/BS and Biology or Chemistry minor
Business BA and Business minor
Criminal Justice BA and Criminal Justice minor
Digital Communication Media BS and Digital Communication minor
Management BS and Business minor
Psychology BA and Psychology minor
