**RE: AN OPEN LETTER TO THE STUDENTS OF MARYMOUNT CALIFORNIA UNIVERSITY**

Dear MCU students,

On behalf of California State University Dominguez Hills, I'm writing to extend our sympathy on the closure of Marymount California University, and a warm invitation to consider our university as a place where you can finish your programs of study.

Students with lower-division standing – that is, those of you who've earned fewer than 60 units, and are typically in the first or second year of enrollment – may still apply for transfer admission. Although our deadline has passed, we will consider applications from MCU students to begin with us in fall 2022. We will provide MCU students with a code to waive our application fee. Our transfer advisors will work with you to identify the best choice of major from those we offer here.

MCU students with junior, senior, or graduate student standing have the same opportunities for admission after the deadline, and a waiver of our usual application fee. In addition, because you are closer to completing your degrees, Dominguez Hills faculty are ready to work with you to identify the courses we offer that will most appropriately complete your MCU degrees.
