



## University of Portland Transfer Opportunities

Founded In 1901, University of Portland is a comprehensive Catholic university grounded in the liberal arts and guided by the Congregation of Holy Cross.

Our campus: With fewer than 4,000 undergraduate students, UP sits on 150 acres on a bluff overlooking the Willamette River and downtown Portland, Oregon. We're small enough that it's easy to meet people but big enough that you'll have plenty of space and things to do.

Our location: Portland and its unique neighborhoods are hubs for coffee shops, food carts, music venues, startups, and miles of hiking and biking paths. A short drive can take you to the Oregon Coast, Columbia River Gorge, or Mount Hood.

Our professors. Faculty here are known for their knowledge, accessibility, and dedication to helping students succeed. With most classes under 30 students, you can be part of the conversation and make yourself heard.

Our programs. Choose from over 40 majors and 37 minors in our College of Arts and Sciences, Pamplin School of Business, School of Nursing, School of Education, and Shily School of Engineering. We have state-of-the-art science and innovation labs, a strong network of industry partners offering real-world experiences, and centers focusing on service, entrepreneurship, and ethics.

Applying as a transfer: You may use the Common Application for transfers or our own University of Portland application. Our preferred transfer application deadline for fall is June 1, and our final deadline is August 1. Classes begin on August 29, 2022.

Scholarship Opportunities: All undergraduate students accepted to UP are considered automatically for institutional scholarships based on academic achievement and range from \$13,000 to \$26,000 per academic year. Transfer student members of Phi Theta Kappa (two-year honor society) are also eligible for PTK Scholarships worth up to \$4,000 per academic year at UP.

Financial Aid Opportunities: Financial aid estimates will be mailed after a student is admitted and completes a FAFSA. DACA/undocumented students will work directly with the Office of Financial Aid to determine eligibility for different types of financial assistance.
